OF THE TURIN-ROME FLIGHT NOW AVAILABLE 5 FREQUENCIES A DAY BETWEEN PIEDMONT AND THE CAPITAL

Caselle Torinese, November 2, 2022 – As of 1 December 2022, ITA Airways will expand its presence in Turin, increasing the daily flight frequencies to and from Rome Fiumicino from the current 21 to 35 per week.

This means that **2 new flights will be added** every day and will be added to the 3 currently scheduled, **for a total of 5 flights.**

One of the most popular connections from Turin therefore returns to full service.

The increase in frequencies in fact allows greater choice and flexibility both for same-day round trips and to increase long-haul connectivity to destinations such as New York, Boston, Miami, Los Angeles and even Sao Paulo, Buenos Aires, Tokyo, New Delhi and the Maldives.
