## TORINO AIRPORT: BRITISH AIRWAYS RESUMES FLIGHTS TO LONDON

The airline will connect Turin with London Heathrow. The carrier initially restarts 2 weekly frequencies, which will gradually increase to 6.

Caselle Torinese, July, 15 2020 - British Airways returns to fly from Torino Airport. The British airline now resumes connections to and from London, operating the Turin-London Heathrow route.

In July there will be two weekly frequencies for the British capital operated by the carrier, which will gradually increase its connections with Turin: in August, in fact, the flights will become 4 per week, then move to 6 weekly frequencies from September, with daily operations except on Fridays.

"We are very pleased that British Airways is returning to operate flights to and from London. This is an important connection for our airport - commented the CEO of Torino Airport, Andrea Andorno - and a further confirmation of our return towards the recovery of air traffic and travel demand. Furthermore, the British market is also strategic from an incoming perspective, since many visitors from Great Britain choose Piedmont to spend their holidays. This factor is even more significant in winter, when traffic from the United Kingdom at our airport increases, due to the skiers who choose our mountains for their stays. We will be ready to welcome them in the next winter season, in full compliance with the health safety provisions".
